## GREEN MOTION LAUNCHES ITS RANGE OF DIRECT CURRENT CHARGING STATIONS AT THE GENEVA MOTOR SHOW

At the 88<sup>th</sup> Geneva International Motor Show Green Motion will be unveiling to the public its brand new RangeXT 11/22 line, the Vaud manufacturer's first product in its range of direct current charging solutions. This station with 11 to 22kW DC power, the only one on the market, is aimed at individuals and firms seeking a rapid, compact and stylish charging solution. Its highly attractive price is unprecedented on the direct current station market. Like all Green Motion products, the RangeXT 11/22 was designed and is produced in Switzerland.

Building on its success and experience with alternating current (AC) stations, Green Motion's management is now convinced that the time has come to enter the direct current (DC) station segment, which will come to account for 20% of the electric vehicle charging infrastructure market.

The models in the RangeXT line for "Range Extender" will each have the following basic features:

- Greater market energy efficiency in excess of 96% thanks to patented technology
- "Vehicle-to-Grid" function and interface with energy storage systems enabling the charging stations to be integrated in future smart power grids
- Compatible with all European, American, Japanese and Chinese DC charging formats
- Flexible and scalable methods of payment

These new DC models will complement Green Motion's AC stations that have enabled the former start-up to establish itself as the Swiss leader in charging infrastructures since 2009.



## FREE SIGN-UP TO THE "EVPASS" NETWORK DURING THE MOTOR SHOW

Launched in June 2016 by Green Motion and its national partners, the evpass charging network is living up to its commitment: it now has 730 public stations throughout Switzerland, complemented by more than 2,000 private stations installed at 500 companies, making it the largest charging network in Switzerland and one of the major European networks. Every day, thousands of users now access "evpass", the aim of which is to expand to 3,000 public charging stations in 2020.

Throughout the Motor Show, visitors will be able to sign up to evpass at the Green Motion stand and enjoy a free one-year subscription. This will give them valuable access to every public network station at a preferential tariff. Moreover, the evpass subscription includes all the benefits of the software suite, which comprises Web and mobile applications that facilitate electric vehicle users' journeys.

Green Motion is exhibiting at the Motor Show for the 8<sup>th</sup> consecutive year, in Hall 5 on Stand 5141, from 8 to 18 March. This year, the company from Vaud is displaying its products alongside its partners Renault and Mobility Carsharing, who will be presenting "ZOE Mobility Carsharing".
